Conflict Resolution Training

Global Majority's Salinas Peacemakers Program at Rancho Cielo and Salinas Community School, is a 15-week elective studies course for student leaders to develop practical skills in conflict resolution and civic engagement.

The program curriculum includes:

- Strategies for dealing with conflict in their personal lives
- Skill building in effective communication
- Training in interest-based negotiation techniques
- A student-led and implemented service learning project in their community
- Guest speakers
- Multiple role-plays and simulations
- Presentation, critical thinking and team work practice

Students who graduate from the course will effectively utilize conflict management skills in all areas of their lives as they break out of the cycles of incarceration and violence.



Service Learning

Service learning requires students to give of their time and talent to advance the common good. The program's service learning project will address a student-selected community conflict that is of concern to the class members.

Some examples of service projects:

- Advocacy campaign for drugfree lifestyles
- Open dialogue workshop with local police officers
- Mentoring children in conflict management
- Training teachers in conflict resolution techniques

Program Accomplishments

- Trained 79 high school students
- Conducted 7 workshops
- Educated 97 at-risk children at 4 elementary and middle schools
